Submit ACT/SAT scores

- REQUIRED for admission to UC Blue Ash for freshman applicants starting fall 2018-19.
- Allow 2-3 weeks for your application to be reviewed after all documents have been received.

 Notification of admission decisions will be sent by email.

- Send FINAL high school transcript AFTER graduation (before July, required for financial aid)

Confirm Your Admission

- Submit confirmation form ucblueash.edu/confirm
- Pay \$50 confirmation/ matriculation fee (online)

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION: incoming first-time freshman who enroll full-time as a degree-seeking student at UCBA and have 1) a completed admission application (to include transcript & application fee) by December 1st of their senior year, 2) a completed admission confirmation on or before May 1st, and 3) a final high school GPA of at least 3.2, are eligible for an automatic UC Blue Ash College Academic Achievement Scholarship (amount varies). Full details online at ucblueash.edu/scholarships.

HONORS PROGRAM: Students with a high school GPA of at least 3.2 and an ACT score of 25 or higher qualify for the UCBA Honors Program and an Honors Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.

If you do not confirm, you will not be able to enroll. Financial aid is not possible if you do not confirm and submit a final transcript.

Please note that only ACT/SAT scores sent directly from **ACT.org** or **collegeboard.org** will be recognized as official.

Attend Orientation

High School Transcripts

- Required or GED
- FINAL transcript must be sent upon graduation inform your high school.
- Exceptions: 30 semester or 45 quarter college credits

College Transcripts

- Official transcripts are required from every college you have attended regardless of the number of credit hours you took or the grades you earned. This includes all post-secondary, College Credit Plus, and
- dual enrollment coursework.

 It is required to submit final transcripts from current coursework after completion.
