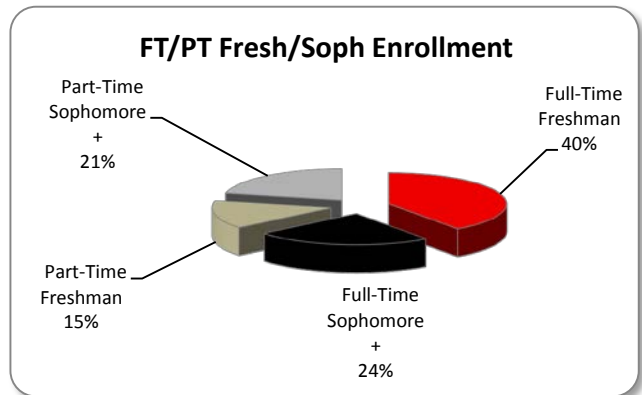


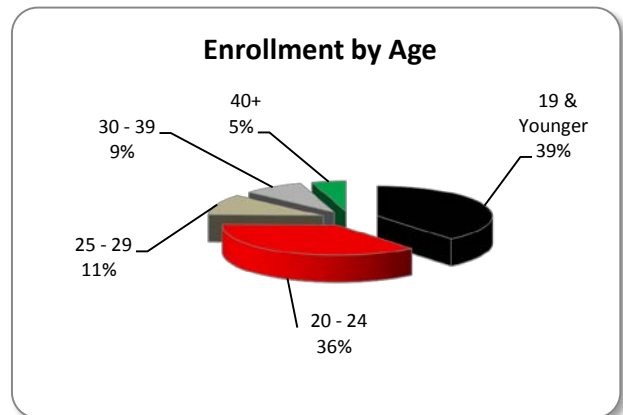
Enrollment by Class Status

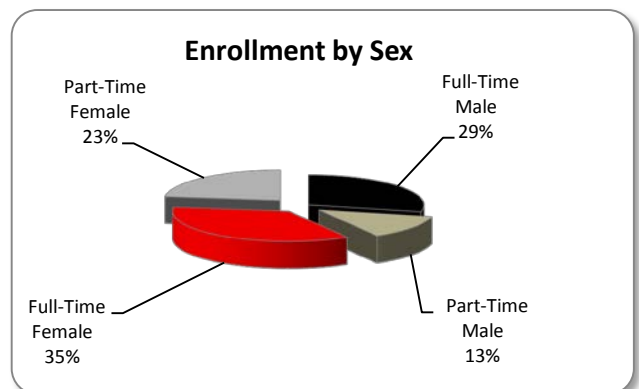

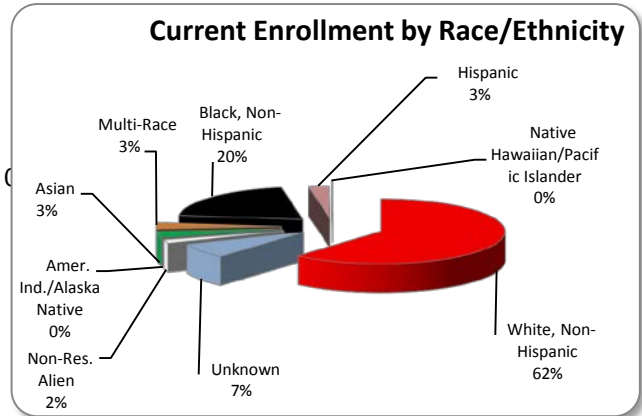
Enrollment by Sex

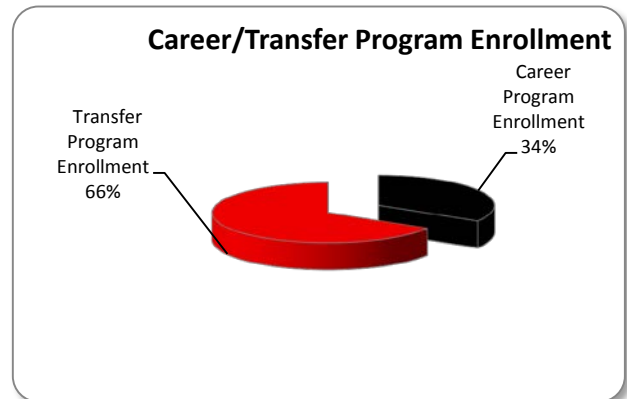
