UC Blue Ash College Emergency Assistance Guide

UC Blue Ash College recognizes the need for the occasional emergency assistance. We have options to assist with special circumstances. Please refer to the details below and contact our UC Blue Ash One Stop Office if you have questions or if you want to learn more about submitting an application.

Women to Self-Sufficiency/The Women's Fund of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation Emergency Fund Grant

The purpose of the Women to Self-Sufficiency/The Women's Fund of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation Emergency Fund Grant is to support vulnerable students experiencing one-time emergencies that may impact their ability to continue their education.

Requirements

Grants are for UC Blue Ash College students with at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Preference will be given to females. Funds from the grant cannot be used for tuition, fees or books. Students must have a zero balance on their student account in order to qualify for the grant. (i.e. There is no outstanding balance for tuition and/or fees on the student's account.) Students will be asked for documentation of their extenuating circumstances. In some cases, exceptions can be made.

Ensminger Loan

The purpose of the Ensminger Loans are to provide stop gap funding for students waiting for financial aid confirmation and needing to pay their tuition bill. The loan is available to students who have an identified repayment source in place. Only UC Blue Ash certificate or degree-seeking students who have filed for financial aid are eligible to apply.

Requirements

Loans for the Charles and Martha Ensminger Loan Fund are for UC Blue Ash College students with at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Funds from the Ensminger can be used for tuition, fees and books. Students who have received previous UC Blue Ash College loans must have a zero balance before any further loans can be made. No interest is charged on these loans.

UCBA Emergency Grant

The purpose of the UCBA Emergency Grant is to support vulnerable students experiencing one-time non-tuition emergencies that may impact their ability to continue their education.

Requirements

Grants are for UC Blue Ash College students with at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Funds from the grant cannot be used for tuition, fees or books. Students must have a zero balance on their student account in order to qualify for the grant. (i.e. There is no outstanding balance for tuition and/or fees on the student's account.) Students are required to provide documentation of their extenuating circumstances.
